

ORDINANCE NO. 2416

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2356 IN REGARD TO THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO CITY EMPLOYEES AND NONELECTED OFFICERS

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of Ordinance numbered 2356 was to fix the compensation to be paid to City employees and nonelected officers; and

**WHEREAS**, there was inadvertently omitted from ordinance 2356 the enacting clause required by KRS 83A.060(2);

**WHEREAS**, the omission of the enacting clause required by KRS 83A.060(2) in ordinance 2356 has caused some concern that the effect of that omission is to invalidate that ordinance, with the consequence that City employees and nonelected officers were paid more than that allowed by the next previous compensation ordinance numbered 2293 during the period from the enactment of ordinance 2356 on July 12, 2011 and the enactment of the next compensation ordinance numbered 2371 on December 4, 2012

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this ordinance is to amend ordinance 2356 to include the enacting clause required by KRS 83A.060(2); and thereby refute the concern about the validity of that ordinance as a consequence of the omission of the enacting clause;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.0 – Ordinance Amendment:**

1.1 Erlanger ordinances 2356 is hereby amended to include the enacting clause required by KRS 83A.060(2), all in conformity with the language in attachment A to this ordinance, which is hereby incorporated herein by reference, with the text being added indicated by a single line drawn underneath it, as required by KRS 83A.060(3).

1.2 This amendment to Erlanger ordinance 2356 shall be retroactively applied to the date of the enactment of ordinance 2356.

1.3 All disbursements pursuant to Erlanger ordinance 2356 prior to the amendment thereof by this ordinance are hereby approved and ratified.

**Section 2.0 – Provisions Severable:**

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

**Section 3.0 – Conflicting Ordinances Repealed:**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 4.0 – Effective Date:**

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

**Section 5.0 – Publication:**

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060(9).

ORDINANCE NO. 2356

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF CITY EMPLOYEES AND NONELECTED CITY OFFICERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 – Pay Plan:

Pursuant to the requirements of K.R.S. 83A.070 (2) and effective at midnight on June 30, 2011, all employees and non-elected officers of the City of Erlanger shall be paid and compensated for their services in conformity with the spread sheet attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
