ORDINANCE NO. 2424**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF ERLANGER, COUNTY OF KENTON, KENTUCKY FOR AN APPROXIMATE 3,900 SQUARE FOOT AREA LOCATED ON THE SOUTHWEST SIDE OF COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, BETWEEN DIXIE HIGHWAY AND HOME STREET, APPROXIMATELY 175 FEET NORTHWEST OF DIXIE HIGHWAY FROM R-1F TO NC (NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL)

WHEREAS, a request for a map amendment was submitted to the Kenton County Planning and Zoning Commission by the City of Erlanger, to change the above described areas from R-1F to NC (Neighborhood Commercial); and

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Planning and Zoning Staff reviewed the application and recommended that the proposed map amendment be approved; and

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Planning & Zoning Commission, upon reviewing the staff recommendations and after holding a public hearing, voted to approve the map amendment on the basis that map amendment consistent with the economy element and recommended land use element map of *Direction 2030: Your Voice. Your Choice*.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ERLANGER, COUNTY OF KENTON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

Section I

That the Erlanger City Council hereby approves said Zoning Map Amendment, changing the zoning for an approximate 3,900 square foot area located on the southwest side of Commonwealth Avenue, between Dixie Highway and Home Street, approximately 175 feet northwest of Dixie Highway, from R-1F to NC (Neighborhood Commercial).

The aforementioned map amendment, as recommended by the Kenton County Planning and Zoning Commission, is adopted and amended on the following bases:

1. The proposed map amendment is consistent with the economy element of *Direction 2030: Your Voice. Your Choice*.
2. The proposed map amendment is consistent with the Recommended Land Use Map element of *Direction 2030: Your Voice. Your Choice*.

Section II

That should any section or part of any section or any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section III

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to the law.
