

ORDINANCE NO. 2353

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, APPROVING AND ADOPTING SUPPLEMENTS TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation, of Cincinnati, Ohio, has completed the 2011 S-17 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Erlanger, which includes all of the ordinances of a general nature from Ordinance 2336 through Ordinance 2351; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 S-17 Supplement include revisions, deletions and additions of certain sections of the Erlanger Code or Ordinances, as recommended by American Legal Publishing Corporation for consistency with state law, and with one another, and to eliminate redundant, obsolete, inconsistent and invalid provisions pursuant to the requirements of K.R.S. 83A.060 (11); and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council of the City of Erlanger to accept the afore described revisions, deletions and additions, so that the Erlanger Code of Ordinances won't have any obsolete, inconsistent or invalid provisions, and will be in conformity with state law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 – Adoption of 2011 S-17 Supplement To The Code of Ordinances

Attached hereto, and incorporated herein by reference, is the 2011 S-17 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Erlanger, as prepared by American Legal Publishing Corporation, which are hereby made a part of the permanent records of the City of Erlanger, and adopted by reference, pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060 (5).

Section 2.0 – Provisions Severable

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Section 3.0 – Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4.0 – Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

Section 5.0 - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060 (9).
